

# **PDF Document Management Trends**

Accusoft conducted a survey to understand the needs of software developers across the United States when it comes to PDF document management features as part of their software offering. This infographic provides insights into how developers leverage PDF editing capabilities within their software and what challenges they face keeping up developing new features.

### PDF editing capabilities



77%

of software developers currently do not have PDF capabilities as part of their offering,



while

of them say this would add value to their product.

ALL respondents that do offer PDF capabilities say that the features are workable but could be improved.
